DAY 1

DAY 3

Rainbow Writing

Gather some paper, and crayons or markers. On your paper draw a rainbow using different colors. For each rainbow line you draw, write a place (example: at home, at school, at church, or at a friend's house) where you can obey and trust God. So if you draw your rainbow with six lines, write six places you can trust and obey God.

P.S. If you wanted to draw a traditional rainbow, you can make a rainbow using: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, and purple!

ASK God to help you trust and obey Him wherever you are.

DAY 4

Trust Here and There

Spend some time talking to God and asking Him to help you trust Him wherever you go. Pray something like this:

"Dear God, I pray that You will help me trust and obey You wherever I go, even when it's hard. Help me to trust and obey at home, school, and when I am with my friends. God, help me to trust and obey You, even when others don't. I love You, God. Amen."
