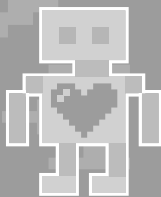

Cookies and a Bike

This week's Bible verse, **Luke 16:10**, tells us when we can be trusted with a little, we can be trusted with a lot. Read the two scenarios below and circle which scenario has the child being faithful and trustworthy to their parents by following directions.

Scenario 1:

Sarah's mom made a fresh batch of cookies that were cooling on the counter. She asked Sarah to watch the cookies so the dog wouldn't eat them while she went to take a break. She also told Sarah not eat one yet, because they were very hot! Sarah wanted a cookie so bad. But, when her mom returned, all the cookies were there! Sarah did such a great job watching the cookies and her mom let her have two cookies instead of one!

Scenario 2:

Nick just got home from a bike ride and his dad asked him to put the bike away so they weren't in the way when their guest came. Nick decided he needed a break and went inside to play video games. Later on, Nick's grandparents came to the house to visit. They had to break the news to Nick that they didn't see his bike and ran it over with their car. Now, because Nick didn't obey his dad he had deal with the consequence of not having a bike for a while until he could show he is trustworthy of keeping his other toys safe.
