DAY 1

Nativity Talk

DAY 3

Sing "The First Noel" with your family. The words are below:

The First Noel, the Angels did say

Noel means Christmas. This famous carol is about the very first Christmas, the night Jesus was born as our Savior and King. When you sing these words and other songs about Jesus' birth, you're sharing the good news about Him!
